# Things to do in Sheffield

- Just an hour's drive from Sheffield is the home of the legendary Robin Hood of Sherwood Forest. On some days in the summer, you can even have a go at archery as well as other summer events.



- Why not go and see a play at the world-famous Crucible Theatre, which is also used as the annual venue for the World Snooker Championships?

- Sheffield's steel is famous around the world. You can visit the Kelham Island Museum, which is a 15-minute walk from the hotel. It tells the story of Sheffield's industrial heritage, and features a working steam engine.



- At a 40-minute drive from the venue, you'll find caverns and caves including Speedwell Cavern, Treak Cliff Cavern and Peak Cavern. Why not combine your visit with a trip up into the Peak District National Park and visit the caverns, and enjoy the delights of the English countryside - or local crafted jewellery?

- Sheffield is a famous sporting city. We have the grounds of Sheffield Wednesday and Sheffield United, and the oldest football club in the world (Sheffield FC, dating back to 1857). Some of the world's top boxers train in Sheffield, including world heavyweight champion Anthony Joshua at the English Institute for Sport. You can even try your hand at axe throwing at Valhalla Axe Throwing, just a 25-minute walk from the playing venue!
- The Meadowhall shopping mall is one of the biggest in the United Kingdom, a 20-25 minute ride on the Sheffield Supertram from the playing venue.
- Our younger participants might be interested in visiting the National Videogame museum, a museum dedicated to computer gaming. It's a 5-10 minute walk from the Hilton hotel.







This year's event will take place at the wonderful Hilton hotel in Sheffield (Victoria Quays, Furnival Road, Sheffield S4 7YA), an appropriate venue for an event of this calibre! We have negotiated a special rate through Bridge Overseas, which organise tournaments for board games across the world.



# Tournament Pules

- We use the original Jumbo Game rules, ISF game Rules & ISF tournament rules: <a href="http://isfstratego.kleier.net/rulreg.html">http://isfstratego.kleier.net/rulreg.html</a>
- New players are welcome provided they know the basic rules. Key tournament rules will be briefly explained at the start of the tournament.
- All events are led by the WC Organisation Team. Their decisions are binding.
- The WC Barrage, WC Classic and Sheffield Open all count for the International STRATEGO Rating: <a href="http://www.kleier.net/rating/general/index.php">http://www.kleier.net/rating/general/index.php</a>.
- The WC will be paired according to the Swiss Perfect system. This means that every player competes in all rounds of the tournament (no knock-out system).
- Seniors and Juniors play during all events with the most recent version of the classic European pieces. Everyone born in 2005 or later is a Junior player.
- The best 4 Classic players of each country qualify for the WC Country Teams.
- If one or more qualified players do not participate, the no. 5 qualifies, then the no. 6, no. 7, etc. Every national Team must have at least 3 players.



#### **Clock Times**

Play time for WC Barrage	1 min setup time + 9 minutes play time. 3 sec per move are free. Start time on clock 02.03. After 9 minutes the game ends in a draw.
Play time for WC Ultimate Lightning	2 min setup time + 28 min play time. 3 seconds per move are free Start time on clock 05.03. After 28 minutes the game ends in a draw.
Play time for WC Classic	5 min setup time + 60 min play time. 4 seconds per move are free Start time on clock 16.04. After 60 minutes the game ends in a draw.
Play time for WC Country Teams and Sheffield Open	5 min setup time + 50 minutes play time. 4 seconds per move are free. Start time on clock 12.04. After 50 minutes the game ends in a draw.
